Oversee job training programs for individuals and businesses to **increase skills, employment opportunities, and business productivity.**

HOW?

Through several NCWorks Career Centers and sometimes the board's business engagement staff will manage special projects directly.

ANNUAL BUDGET (WIOA only)

Approx. \$6.8M for adult, dislocated worker, and youth

WHATS' GOING ON RIGHT NOW?

Catalyst 20/20: Companies can get up to \$20K to train existing workers in whatever they deem critical to business.
